<u>A Letter from the Pastor</u>

Dear Parish Family.

Well I want to wish all our students all the choicest blessings of this new year.

This past Friday I had the pleasure of offering Mass for the students and teachers of Our Lady Star of the Sea School and to welcome them to the 2017-2018 academic year. We pray for the Holy Spirit to guide and lead the staff and faculty and students in this most wonderful year. "Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful, enkindle them with the fire of your love, send forth your Spirit, and we shall be created and you shall renew the face of the earth"

These have been difficult times with the threats coming from North Korea, the clean-up efforts of Houston and Louisiana, and now the impending arrival of Hurricane Irma.

The Lord is testing us with a call to greatness and generosity and solidarity with our brothers and sisters who are suffering the effects of this strong weather season. I have friends in the Houston area and I haven't heard from them and then I remember how difficult times were here four years ago when Hurricane Sandy wiped out electricity, gas and washed away many homes. I am grateful for all the prayers that being offered.

Rev. Rick Warren, the pastor of Saddleback Church, in California, comments on these hurricane disasters with an article about one of his co-pastors, Tom Holladav.

"Tom Holladay, teaching pastor at Saddleback Church, offered some words of hope to the flood victims in Houston, Texas with an article that appeared on the Fox News website. Holladay can empathize with the people in Texas and Louisiana who have lost everything because his home was covered by 9 feet of water when a levee broke, flooding Marysville, California in 1986.

Holladay says his family needed to quickly learn four simple truths in order to maintain hope during the recovery, which must be measured in years, not months. These truths are also a guide for how we can reach out to victims of the flood.

People will find hope in gifts that provide for their basic needs

Holladay says he appreciated the single woman who gave up her apartment to give his family a place to temporarily live, when a truck brought meals for all the workers, and when a church replaced his pastor's library. Your church could offer hope by providing pastors who need help ministering to their congregations with items they can give to others. Or, you could help a pastor get back to his full capacity by providing for his needs.

People will find hope in the prayers that we pray

Holladay says people in a crisis need others to pray for them because, often, they are so busy they barely have time to pray. Our congregations can pray consistently over the next year or more for the people put in crisis by this flood.

People will find hope by trusting God one day at a time

Holladay says God gave him the strength and hope he needed each day. He says hung onto God's promise from Nehemiah 2:20, The God of Heaven will give us success; we his servants will start rebuilding. Consider how you can help a local pastor teach his congregation to trust God one day at a time.

People will find hope in long-term volunteers

Holladay says it was a blessing to see volunteers who kept helping in the recovery months and years after the flood. He notes that Saddleback Church is making plans to send teams to help with the recovery over the next several years."

On Monday, we remember the events of September 11, 2001. It has been sixteen years since that dreadful day of disaster and yet in the hearts of so many families it has been one long day of unending loss. Our nation changed that day and we still need healing and God's grace to be inspired for our future. Prayer once again does help.

This weekend the Archdiocese is asking all pastors to take up a collection to help in disaster relief.

Also this weekend the Dominican Sisters of Blauvelt will be offering chance books for their motherhouse in Blauvelt, New York. 60 years ago, I began the first grade at Saint Luke's School in the Bronx. They were the teachers and role models of my faith since 1957. They are now dear friends and provide a powerhouse of prayer for my ministry. So thank you for whatever help you can provide.

On September 8th we celebrated the birthday of Anthony Gorgia, now in Rome at the Pontifical North American College Seminary, and also it's the Feast of the Birthday of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Since we are all under her mantle, we trust in her intercession for all of us these days.
