A Letter from the Pastor

Dear Parish Family,

I want to unite myself to all of you in wishing you and your families a Blessed Easter. I most especially want to thank you for your prayers and letters which have been a source of comfort and inspiration. As some of you may know, I have been on a medical leave since 11 February, and I am seeing now the fruits of all these programs that are designed to help me to become a "better version of myself." The insights I have received will hopefully make me a better priest and pastor, as I attend to the improvement of my body, mind, and spirit.

To be honest with you, I somewhat resisted beginning this therapeutic process, and yet the moment I said "YES" to entering into this treatment program, I felt the Lord's presence and peace. This is Jesus' Easter gift to all of us. Life can be intense and complicated, and I am with about 40 other priests, brothers, and sisters, all of whom, like me, are facing a range of issues that called for a "time out" from our ministries. I have been amazed at their level of honesty, openness, and generosity of spirit. I know I have benefitted by being in their company, as well the professional staff who are dedicated to giving us all "a new life." I am also grateful to the archdiocese, which has worked with me and supported me in undergoing this therapy program.

I miss you terribly, but I do look forward each day to returning to Our Lady Star of the Sea Parish. You are in my prayers, and I hope I can count on yours as well. Each day makes me realize just how much I love you and want to continue to serve you as pastor. I apologize for the inconvenience my extended absence may have caused, particularly at this solemn time of year. May the words of Jesus to his disciples, "Peace and Be Not Afraid" bless you throughout this joyous Easter Season.
