Saint of the Week

St. Peter Claver – Sept. 9, Patron of Black Missions

Peter was a Spanish Jesuit sent to Cartagena (now Columbia) in 1610 – the port of entry for 1,000 slaves per month to work in the mines. The conditions of the journey were unspeakably atrocious; slaves packed in dark holds, chained together, lying in their own filth, fed just enough to keep them alive. One third died during the journey. For those who remained, Peter Claver devoted his life. He would enter the revolting inferno, treating their wounds distributing food and drink. Given that Christianity was ostensibly the religion of the slave masters, Claver tried to instill in the slaves a sense of human dignity and preciousness in God's eyes. Peter often encountered angry oppositions from business and civil authorities. During his forty years, he baptized over 300,000 slaves – he followed them to the mines and plantations interceding for them. He called himself the "Slave of the Negroes forever." In 1650, struck by the plague, he remained in his cell, virtually alone and in shocking neglect. He was canonized a saint in 1888 by Pope Leo XIII. (JM)
