St. Benedict Joseph Labre-April 16 Poor Man of God-Vagabond Saint

Benedict, a religious vagabond, was born in the south of France. The eldest of 15 children, at 12, he was sent to live with his uncle, a parish priest. When his uncle died, he devoted his life entirely to God. Due to his youth, he was turned away from the Trappists and other religious communities. He sought cloister within the world, and began a pilgrimage, wandering thousands of miles praying at shrines and churches. He dressed in rags and never bathed which discouraged human contact and contributed to prayerful isolation. When food was not offered he lived off what was discarded by the roadside. He was frequently harassed and shoved away. Settling in Rome, he slept in the Coliseum. He died at 35, April 16, 1783. Immediately following this, children called through the streets, "the saint is dead." His biography was published and through this, his parents learned what had become of the long-missing son. (JM)

LENT 2014

Reconciliation Monday: The Archdiocese of New York has designated **Monday, April 14th** as **Reconciliation Monday** to give everyone an opportunity to receive the sacrament. All parishes within the Archdiocese have the Sacrament of Reconciliation that day. We will hear confessions from 3-9 p.m.

Confessions: Confessions: Saturday from 3:30 to 4PM and from 5 to 5:30PM in the Church. Last confessions before Easter: Good Friday, April 18th, from 12 Noon to 2:30PM.

Fast and Abstinence: Good Friday, April 18th, is a day of fast and abstinence. The obligation of abstinence (refraining from eating meat) begins at the age of 14. The law of fasting (limiting oneself to one full meal and two lighter meals) obliges all between the ages of 19-59.

Stations of the Cross: are held every Friday at 8PM during Lent. On Good Friday, April 18th, we will hold Meditation on the Passion of Jesus Christ in word and song through the Eyes of His Mother Mary at 8PM in the Church.

Healing Masses and Services: Healing Mass: April 15 at 8PM. Healing Service: May 6 at 3:30PM.

BAPTISM PREPARATION POLICY

All Parish Families preparing for the Baptism of their child must attend the Parish Baptismal Preparation Program. The program is held mostly on the 2nd and 4th Sunday's of the month at 12 Noon in the Athletic Center (Damato Meeting Room). We invite you to bring along your baby's Godparents to hear this special presentation. Please call the rectory for a Registration Packet before attending the Sunday Meeting. A copy of the child's birth certificate is needed. The sponsor must have proof of Confirmation, a sponsor certificate (see sponsor certificate information below) and must be at least 14 years of age. The Baptismal donation of \$100 and the yellow registration form must be brought to the Parish Office (Mon.-Fri. 9 to 4PM), prior to the Baptism Meeting. You may then bring the completed registration form to the meeting of your choice.
