Dear Parish Family,

As we continue our journey through this Easter Season toward the great feast of Pentecost. I would like to quote from an amazing little book called "Jesus Calling" by Sarah Young. This book is a devotional and the reflections are given as if Jesus were having a personal conversation with you. I would like to quote today's segment as well as for Sunday, April 17, 2016.

"Let me fill you with Love, Joy and Peace. These are Glory Gifts, flowing from my healing presence. Though you are an earthen vessel, I designed you to be filled with heavenly contents. Your weakness is not a deterrent to being filled with my Spirit, on the contrary, it provides an opportunity for My Power to shine forth more brightly.
