### **St. Catherine of Siena – April 29**

Born in 1347, she was the most remarkable woman of her time. In childhood, she consecrated herself to God, refused her parent's wishes to marry enduring persecution, even in her own house. She was allowed to become a 3<sup>rd</sup> Order Dominican nun. She nursed the infected people from pestilence, and converted thousands. Two years later, Catherine went to Avignon to intercede for the Florentines, who were under Papal interdict and to influence Pope Gregory XI to return to Rome. Her life had been glorified by God with wondrous gifts and miracles. She died at age 33. She had a great theological mind, wrote "Dialogues" and some 400 Letters. In 1970, Pope Paul VI declared her a Doctor of the Church. St. Catherine also received the Holy Stigmata of Christ. (JM)

All Parish Families preparing for the Baptism of their child must attend the Parish Baptismal Preparation Program. The program is held mostly on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday's of the month at 12 Noon in the Athletic Center (Damato Meeting Room). We invite you to bring along your baby's Godparents to hear this special presentation. Please call the rectory for a Registration Packet before attending the Sunday Meeting. A copy of the child's birth certificate is needed. The sponsor must have proof of Confirmation, a sponsor certificate (see sponsor certificate information below) and must be at least 14 years of age. The Baptismal donation of \$100 and the yellow registration form must be brought to the Parish Office (Mon.-Fri. 9 to 4PM), prior to the Baptism Meeting. You may then bring the completed registration form to the meeting of your choice.
