**Hero Saint of the Week-St. Camillus de Lellis – July 14**  
 When Camillus was in his twenties, he was a 6'6" soldier of fortune, with a temper, a gambling habit and a penchant for brawling. During a battle, he developed a serious leg sore and went to San Giacomo hospital in Rome, working as a servant while undergoing treatment. Dismissed due to his temper and gambling, he lost everything including his clothes. Upon taking a job as a builder for a Capuchin Monastery, he had a spiritual renewal. He Returned to San Giacomo and devoted himself to the sick and dying. He volunteered during the plague and scoured caves and catacombs seeking the suffering. In 1584, he was ordained and founded the Ministers of the Sick, whose religious habit bore a Red Cross. His community grew to 15 houses and 8 hospitals. Camillus suffered terribly with his leg sore, until his death in 1614 at age 64. St. Camillus was declared Patron Saint of the Sick and of Nurses. (JM)
