Pastor's Letter

Dear Parish Family,

Well, we are coming down to the wire this academic year with all the celebrations of major events in the life of the parish. We had the Sacrament of Confirmation for 16 people who participated in RCIC, the rite of Christian Initiation of Children and three of them also made their First Communion last week on Pentecost Sunday. By the grace of God, we have now 16 new special ministers of Holy Communion, who have been mandated to not only serve at Mass, but also carry our precious Lord Jesus to those who are frail, and homebound.

Last Saturday, I was invited to give a day of prayer for the Vigil of Pentecost to about 26 leaders of the Staten Island Council of Churches at the Saint Joseph Hill Retreat Center. It was a wonderful gathering from about 10am to 3PM. The gathering represented many Catholic as well as Protestant Church members. The highlight of the day was, of course, the sun came out after a rainy morning. I invited people after the singing, a talk, silent prayer in the chapel and a generous lunch; to go out with one other person for an Emmaus Walk. They were to spend the next half hour with someone of another faith and talk about their awareness of Christ working in their life. It was powerful. It was insightful and they came back enthused. I knew Pentecost was near as I listened to their testimony toward the end of the day.

How wonder struck was Father Reynor Santiago last Saturday! First of all, I knew that getting back from Saint Joseph Hill HS was impossible for 3:30 confessions and so I invited Father Reynor to hear confessions for the first time in his life. I was up front with him and told him it would be a marathon. Ever since Father David mentioned the power of the sacrament of confession for the first Saturday of the month. June was the sixth month many people were coming to receive the Lord's mercy. So Father Reynor heard confessions non-stop from 3:30 to 6:30PM. To put it mildly, he was blown away by the awesomeness of that experience. It melted his heart. You know for yourself that you can only learn so much from books and a classroom, but when you begin doing something brand new it leaves a deep impression. He had to leave quickly since he was flying to Rome at 10PM to take his final exams this week. (Hint: pray for him). He will return in mid-June and will have some free time before beginning in July at Saint Benedict's Parish in the Bronx. After his confessions, I gave him a set of photos that were taken at his ordination and a copy of my homily for his First Mass of Thanksgiving and more cards and notes arrived this week. When he left and said good-bye, he thanked me profusely and said. "It was all worth it, (Meaning the struggle to get through the seminary)."

No sooner did I close the door on Father Reynor, I was called to welcome and take a photo shot with our wedding Jubilarians who are this year celebrating 25 & 50 years of Holy Matrimony. What a gift to have Father Chris Argano lead us in the Eucharist at 5:30PM last Saturday. His mom and dad were among the couples being so honored. Everyone had a great time, the food, the drinks, the DJ and the music, the photo shoots under the gold and silver balloon arches were all a hit. Every family had their own "wedding cake" to share with their families. It was all a pleasant surprise and I am so glad. Indeed the example of faithful, fruitful loving families is such a backbone to every parish life. May the Lord continue to bless.

Father Joseph Roesch, MIC was ordained in our parish 25 years ago and on July 2nd at the 11AM (new time for Sunday morning) Mass he will offer a Mass of Thanksgiving. His parents, long time parishioners of OLSS, Bill and Kay Roesch, will soon be moving to Florida. I am delighted that Father Joe, who is currently the vice provincial of his community was given permission to come home from Rome to gather with his family and friends for this monumental milestone in his life. So if you are not out of town on the 4th of July weekend, please come and support and be blessed by Father Joseph Roesch's anniversary Mass.


