St. Adelaide, Virgin - June 15

Adelaide was born near Brussels and at age 7, she entered a Cistercian convent and remained there the rest of her life. The community was inspired by her spirit of humility. However, at an early age, she contracted leprosy and had to be isolated. Adelaide endured intense suffering and became paralyzed and was afflicted with blindness. Her greatest consolation was receiving Holy Communion. She was not allowed to receive from the chalice for fear of contagion. However, Our Lord appeared to her with the assurance that to receive under one species was sufficient. St. Adelaide received many visions and ecstasies and died in 1250. -JM
