**Blessed Osanna of Mantua Virgin – June 18**

Osanna was born in 1449 to noble class parents. At age 5, she experienced a vision of paradise. She rejected her father's wishes to marry and at age 17, became a Dominican tertiary. However, she did not profess until 37 years later because she felt responsible to care for her brothers and their families after the death of her parents. Osanna had particular mystical experiences; she participates in the Mysteries of Christ's Passion, sharing the crowning with thorns, piercing of the side, and the wounds on the hands and feet. Although the wounds did not appear, she suffered physical pain as if they were there. Osanna expended much time and money to help the poor. Daily, she visited the sick, and comforted the afflicted. All the while, she led an austere life and had numerous visions of Jesus and Mary. (JM)

## A MESSAGE FROM FR. TOM

Dear Parish Family,

I want to honor all our graduates from Our Lady Star of the Sea School, kindergarten and our Class of 2015. Last Friday we were happy to host the baccalaureate Mass of the Class of 2015 from Saint Joseph by the Sea High School. Father Michael Riley, principal and celebrant gave a brilliant homily about a woman born in Italy who had planned with her husband and family in 1927 to sail to Buenos Aires. The political scene in Italy was threatening with the dawn of Fascism. After handing over their life savings to pay for the long journey at sea, they ran into further problems. They could not sell their business nor their home which was their only means of being able to afford a new life in South America. On the morning that the ship call "Principessa" set sail, they stood on the dock weeping as over 500 passengers left.

It would be almost ten years later before this family was able to make the journey to Buenos Aires, and in time one of their daughters married a man living in Argentina, who would later be the parents of Jorge Maria Bergoglio. "The Principessa" never made it to their port in Buenos Aires. It sank off the coast of Argentina and over 490 passengers drowned. If this heartbroken family had boarded that ship it's most likely would never have had a "Pope Francis". That family was the grandparents of Pope Francis.

The point of Father Riley's graduation homily is that life gives us great opportunities and some crushing misfortunes. However God can bring good out of apparent tragedy. The story was well timed, given the unbridled optimism of graduates. It's ultimately our complete trust in God, every day and in all circumstances and helps us have the faith to endure the good and bad in life.



Thomas Luisi and may more be inspired to in his example the "Semper Fidelis" that should be in each of us to God.
