#### Blessed Osanna of Montrea, Virgin - June 20

Osanna was born in 1449 in Montrea, Italy to parents of noble class. She had her first mystical experience at age 5 - a vision of paradise. Rejecting please of marriage, she became a novice in the Domenican Teriary. She was not professed until age 37 because of taking care of her brother and their families after the death of her parents. Between the ages 17 and 22, she had mystical experiences of participating physically in the Mysteries of Christ's passion. She shared in the crowning of Thorns, piercing of our Lord's side, and the wounds of the hands and feet – she experienced the pain without appearance of the wounds.
