A MESSAGE FROM FR. TOM

Dear Parish Family,

I want to alert you to a spiritual danger for our children, that seems innocent and harmless but in reality is a real evil. It's called the "Charlie Challenge". A concerned parishioner wrote a letter to me with regard to this and I am speaking to the upper grades this week about this topic.

Dear Father Tom,

I am writing to you as a concerned Catholic parent about a game that I heard is being played in our school as well as other schools within the tri state area. The game is called "The Charlie Challenge". The game is very similar to the Ouija board or also called the spirit board which is used to conjure up evil spirits. The game is apparently played with drawing a star on a piece of paper with "yes or no" written in boxes and placing two pencils in form of a cross then asking if Charlie can come out and play and make himself known thru moving the pencil to answer questions in the form of a seance. As a Catholic, it is our responsibility to be aware of and protect our children from the harm it can bring to our children, our families and our school.

The Lord repeatedly condemns any and all occultic practices, including divination. While many Bible passages could be cited, the following one is typical of his view of occultic practices: "Let no one be found among you who sacrifices his son or daughter in the fire, who practices divination or sorcery, interprets omens, engages in witchcraft, or casts spells, or who is a medium or spiritist or who consults the dead. Anyone who does these things is detestable to the Lord" (Dt 18:10-12, NIV).

The Ouija board and any game similar to it, is far from harmless, as it is a form of divination (seeking information from supernatural sources). The fact of the matter is, the Ouija board really does work, and the only "spirits" that will be contacted through it are evil ones.

It's true that many people view the Ouija board as harmless. They often claim, "Oh, I don't believe in it," or something to this effect. However, a disbelief in something does not necessarily mean that something isn't real. The Ouija board has an objective reality that exists apart from a person's perception of it. In other words, it's real even if you don't believe in it. And we know this because God himself tells us so.

On the experiential side of the issue, we have the testimony of the Church's exorcists. Their experience shows that Ouija boards are far from harmless. Some investigating supernatural phenomena from a Catholic perspective have gone so far as to say that 90 percent of their very worst cases involving demonic activity have been linked to the use of the Ouija board.

Simply put, nothing positive can ever come from the use of the Ouija board or games like it, and God warns us against such things for our own spiritual safety.

In today's times with so many attacks on our children from so many sources: social media, the internet, TV, radio...let us not give the devil another opportunity to attack our kids.

Father I ask that you will reveal this information to the parents of Our Lady Star Of The Sea as I know and believe in your great love for God, our children and our school .
