**HERO/SAINT OF THE WEEK**

June 3 – St. Charles Lwanga and 22 companions are the first martyrs of black Africa. Born in Buddu, Uganda, Charles became a Christian and head of the king’s pages. He spent much of his energy protecting his young pages from the chief’s sexual designs on them. Charles instructed the pages in the faith and when their lives were threatened, he baptized them. Charles and the pages were forced to confess their faith, arrested and march 16 miles to Namugango on Lake Victoria. Three of the youths were killed on the way. Charles and his companions were forced to lie on mats of reed, which were wrapped and tied around them, fuel poured over them and slowly burned alive on the Feast of the Ascension, June 3, 1886. ## Antonio Meucci First Place Young Inventors



The teachers, administration, and all the students of OLSS send a resounding “Congratulations!” to eighth grade students Andrew Coleman and Robert Jones for their First Place win at the *Antonio Meucci Young Inventors’ Competition*. The competition is sponsored by Staten Island’s own Garibaldi-Meucci Museum and Time Warner Cable and is inspired by the accomplishments and legacy of inventor/innovator Antonio Meucci. Andrew and Robert are the inventors of a prototype for a robotic snow removal system, *Snowbot Master 3000 version 2.0*. They first earned a spot among an elite group of only 15 inventions narrowed down from a large applicant pool from many of Staten Island’s public, private, and parochial schools. All finalists presented their ideas to a panel of expert judges in May. A unique idea, diagrams, prototype, and a presentation demonstrating their understanding of the scientific principles behind their invention design all contributed to the first place honor. The students of OLSS continue to shine in many arenas!
