**HERO/SAINT OF THE WEEK**

May 17 –St. Pascal Baylon was born in Spain in 1540. In his early years, he was a shepherd and while tending his sheep, he taught himself to read. At 24, having already advanced in piety, he entered the poor Reformed Franciscan Monastery of Valencia and became a simple lay brother. He often said, "I was born poor and I am resolved to die in poverty and penance." St. Pascal had an intense devotion to our Lord in the Holy Eucharist. God often favored him with ecstasies and raptures, but so great was his humility that he carefully avoided whatever might redound to his honor or praise. He devoted himself to the care of the sick and poor, and served one mass after another each morning. Many cures and miracles and curious knocking sounds continued for two hundred years after his death at his tomb. He is the patron saint of Eucharistic devotion. (JM)
