HERO/SAINT OF THE WEEK

May 30-St. Dymphna was born in 7th or 9th century. Her father, Damon, was a pagan chieftan and her mother was a beautiful and devout Christian. When her mother died, her father Damon began to suffer mental illness to his grief. Not able to find another beautiful wife, he attempted to marry his own daughter, Dymphna, who, in turn, fled and hid in Belgium. Damon found her and tried to persuade her to return with him to Ireland. St. Dymphna refused. Damon took his sword and struck off her head. She was 15 years old when she received the crown of martyrdom. St. Dymphna is the patron saint of those suffering from mental and nervous conditions. She was buried in Gheel, Belgium. (JM)

All Parish Families preparing for the Baptism of their child must attend the Parish Baptismal Preparation Program. The program is held on the 2nd and 4th Sunday of the month at 12 Noon in the Athletic Center (Damato Meeting Room). We invite you to bring along your baby's Godparents to hear this special presentation. Please call the rectory for a Registration Packet before attending the Sunday Meeting. A copy of the child's birth certificate, proof of Confirmation for sponsors (the sponsor must be at least 14 years of age), the Baptismal donation of \$100 and the yellow registration form must be brought to the Parish Office (Mon.- Fri. 9 to 4PM), prior to the Baptism Meeting. You may then bring the completed registration form to the meeting of your choice.
