**Nov. 13 – St. Frances Xavier Cabrini**

**Mother Cabrini is the first U.S. canonized a saint and is patron of immigrants and hospital administrators. Born in Pania, Italy, she was twice refused entrance into a convent due to health issues. The local bishop encouraged her to become a missionary so she founded the Missionary Sisters of the Sacred Heart. Pope Leo XIII told her to minister to the Italian immigrants in the U.S. When she arrived in NY in 1889, Archbishop Corrigan was unwelcoming. She cited her letters from the Pope and stayed. Although she received no diocesan support, she started teaching children, visiting the sick, and feeding the hungry. Shopkeepers donated what they could. Mother Cabrini established an orphanage, novitiate and a hospital in Chicago and New Orleans. Our church has a stained glass window in her honor. (JM)**

All Parish Families preparing for the Baptism of their child must attend the Parish Baptismal Preparation Program. The program is held on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of the month at 12 Noon in the Athletic Center (Damato Meeting Room). We invite you to bring along your baby's Godparents to hear this special presentation. Please call the rectory for a Registration Packet before attending the Sunday Meeting. A copy of the child's birth certificate is needed. The sponsor must have proof of Confirmation, a sponsor certificate (see sponsor certificate information below) and must be at least 14 years of age. The Baptismal donation of \$100 and the yellow registration form must be brought to the Parish Office (Mon.- Fri. 9 to 4PM), prior to the Baptism Meeting. You may then bring the completed registration form to the meeting of your choice.

## SEED

**Success through Early Exploration and Discovery**  
Our Lady Star of the Sea Preschool has an exciting SEED program. In a developmentally age appropriate and print rich environment, our preschoolers move from learning center to learning center, exploring and discovering the world of Reading, Math, Science, and Social Studies. Incorporating Art, Music and Movement, and Computer technology helps to strengthen our preschoolers to become highly active and eager learners! Our 3 year olds initially focus on the social and readiness skills. As the year progresses, there is more in depth focus on the children's literacy program *The Letter People*. Our 4 year olds are immersed in the new innovative *Happily Ever After*, a readiness program with children's literature at the heart! This program teaches a rich curriculum of early literacy skills such as story structure and appreciation, print and book awareness, letter recognition and naming, auditory discrimination, phonological and phonemic awareness, listening and direction following, oral language development, and emergent writing through children's dictation. The SPARKS program, which focuses on physical activity and healthy nutrition, is also used. Our full day 4 year olds also have the opportunity to spend time each week using the computers in our state of the art computer lab! 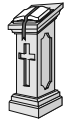
## OLSS SPORTS NEWS
