**St. Martin de Porres (1579-1639)**

Born in Lima, Peru, he was the son of a Spanish nobleman (governor of Panama) and a free black woman named Anne. He learned the barber profession, which included hair cutting with surgical and medical shells. However, at age 15, he applied for admission to the Dominicans, as the lowliest position lay helper responsible for sweeping and cleaning latrines. He work the Dominican habit and was soon in charge of the infirmary, where the sick experienced medical and miraculous healings. St. Martin's mere presence or touch brought healings. His charity extended outside the monastery to the sick and abandoned of Peru; the Indians, the poor, and the slaves. Martin treated sick and hungry animals with the same devotion as he did to humans. Martin was able to communicate with animals. His other supernatural gifts included levitation during prayer, healing, clairvoyance, power to pass through locked doors and to become invisible at will. He also had the gift of bilocation, appearing in China, Mexico and North Africa, having never left Peru. In 1962, he was canonized a saint, patron of all who work for social injustice. (JM)

You may then bring the completed registration form to the meeting of your choice.
