**St. Thomas of Villanova – Sept. 8**

Thomas was born in Spain in 1488. From his parents he learned charity for the poor, which he practiced from early childhood and which distinguished his later life. At age 15, he entered the University of Alcala and after eleven years, became a professor of Philosophy. In 1518, he entered the Augustinian Order and was ordained in 1520. With his zeal, he became known as the "Apostle of Spain." In his episcopacy, the Saint lived as a poor man, giving outstanding examples of piety and humility to his brother Bishops. St. Thomas used his pursuit of learning as an instrument of the Gospel of Love. (JM)

## A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parish Family,

Welcome back all students of Our Lady Star of the Sea School and Religious Education and a big hello to our newest students. The school year has started and we are eager to ask the Holy Spirit to let you be filled with wisdom, guidance, truth and goodness as you strive to make the most of this academic year 2014-2015.

I want to mention some of the events that are happening around the parish this month. The carport by the rectory is currently being transformed into a garage. The Mass for Healing will occur on Tuesday September 9<sup>th</sup> at 7:30PM. I am grateful to the prayer group leaders and prayer warriors who are most welcome to join us in prayer for all who will attend. On the other Tuesday evenings from 7:30 -9PM we will begin a new Charismatic Prayer group that will include a time for praise, song, a teaching and witness and intercession. If you are free, come and join us in the Damato Room in the Athletic Center.

I have started here at Our Lady Star of the Sea as well as both at Our Lady of Pity and before that Holy Child, a men's bible study and prayer time for early on Saturday morning from 7-8:30 AM in the rectory conference room. We will provide the coffee and you're welcome to bring the bagels. It's been my experience that most working men have no venue during the week to speak about their faith, ask questions or delve into the Sunday Eucharistic Scriptures. This has been powerful in my experience. Generally, it starts off slowly but it builds and all men are invited. I would like to begin this on Saturday September 6. The reason for the early hour is that it will not hopefully interfere with family obligations later in the day.

As the new academic year begins there will be many meetings. For me, I will still be meeting and greeting teachers, catechists, adorers, parish council, finance council members, prayer groups, sports council, engaged couples, ministers of music as well as greeting the parish staffs of the other three parishes in our four parish cluster.

There's a Meet and Greet for "Making all Things New" and the parish staffs of Our Lady Star of the Sea, Our Lady Help of Christians, Saint Joseph and Saint Thomas and Saint John Neumann for us all to get to know each other and review all that has happened since last winter.

On September 13<sup>th</sup> at Noon Mass Our Lady of Pity will officially end their 100<sup>th</sup> Jubilee with a Mass of Thanksgiving offered by newly consecrated Bishop Peter Byrne. And on September 28<sup>th</sup> Our Lady of Pity will have a Gala Dinner at Nicotra's Restaurant at the Hilton, and Cardinal Dolan will be the guest of honor.
