**HERO/SAINT OF THE WEEK –**

**Blessed Frederic Ozanam – Sept. 8**

In 1831, Frederic was appalled when he encountered such hostility to Christianity at the University of Paris. He came to realize that Christianity is not about ideas but about deeds inspired by love. He formed a Christian lay group that would be immersed in performing acts of charity for the world's poor. This became the St. Vincent DePaul Society. This Society helped the poor of Paris, who lived in unbelievable squalor in overcrowded, disease-ridden slums. Frederic wrote, "It is the battle of those who have nothing and those who have too much; it is the violent collision of opulence and poverty which makes the earth tremble under our feet." His concern was not only the welfare of the poor but the credibility and integrity of the gospel. The poor, he said, are "messengers of God to test our justice and our charity, and to save us by our works." (JM)
