A Letter from the Pastor

Dear Parish Family,

Thanks be to God for all the prayers and sacrifices that were offered this past week for all our family and friends living in Florida. Many have lost power but word has gotten back to me from several of my friends, that although the sound of the wind was intensely horrible and the many trees were down and maybe some slight shingle damage, all of them seemed to survive Hurricane Irma and most grateful to God to be alive.

We will keep monitoring this situation and thank you in advance for your generosity to financially help these victims of the storm's fury.

The Relics of Saint Padre Pio are on display Saturday and Sunday, September 16 and 17 at Saint Patrick's Cathedral. The cathedral will be open from early morning until 9PM each of these days. All are invited to come and venerate this most powerful saint of mercy and forgiveness.

I am writing this letter on Tuesday the Feast of the Holy Name of Mary. This morning Father David Rider reminded us of the power of the rosary especially when odds are stacked against us, it is our weapon of peace. Unfortunately the Rosary hangs from bed posts, rear view mirrors or in silk lined purses in many pocket books. To not pray the rosary and to have these sacred articles lie around is no better than good luck charms. Praying the rosary is the greatest weapon we have against disunity, war, violence, hatred and natural disasters. Praying the rosary is weakening the power of the Evil One and invites us to see the life of Jesus through the eyes of Mary, our Blessed Mother, who intimately cares for each of one us.

The Legion of Mary will sponsor a Rosary Rally on the front steps of Our Lady Star of the Sea Church on October 14th at 9:45AM, please plan to give a public demonstration of our faith in Our Lady's plan for peace in our world. As Catholics this prayer releases the graces for ongoing personal conversion, communal conversion, and equipping us to be missionaries to carry the Gospel message to the whole world.

In this letter I am going to mention a few concerns and opportunities for your participation and help.

During the month of August, Father Basil was a spiritual director on a bus pilgrimage to the Catholic Shrines in Montreal, Quebec and Canada. It was a deeply moving experience. It seemed that the bus driver mentioned to Father Basil that his company had to make room for new school buses and that they would be willing to donate three buses for Father Basil's home town of Kafanchan, Nigeria. Well today these buses, all in excellent condition are parked in the Athletic Center parking lot. Father Basil needs \$9000 to ship these vehicles to Nigeria. So far by word of mouth about half of the money has been raised. Would you like to help his cause? Please contact Father Basil with your financial help in this regard. And as he always says, "God is good all the time and all the time God is good". Thank you in advance for your support. Also coming down the pike I would like to inform you that the Archdiocese of New York will be contacting us to participate in the "Renew and Rebuild" capital campaign. I haven't heard what the final amount assessed to us is, but that the split is 75/25, the Archdiocese will keep the twenty five percent and the rest will go to the parish. Looking ahead, I know that we have need of a new roof for the school and athletic center so that Con Ed can give us the solar panels that will greatly reduce our electric bill. We are also seeking to pay back part of the portion of our debt for the Church which is currently about \$8.2 Million and that for every dollar of \$1.35 million we raise, the Archdiocese will match that, so that \$2.7 million not covered through our loan payment will help up finish off this debt.

The Dominican Sisters of Blauvelt were most grateful for your generous support for their order as they offered their annual fund raiser to help support the 110 sisters of their community. Last week we donated \$ in their chance book drive.

Representatives from the Office of Safe Environment will be touring our school on September 20th to see how we are in compliance with the Church's policy of protecting our children. They will tour the school and give us their opinion on our compliance.

I want to honor our Music Ministry in our parish and re-echo the call for singers, musicians and men, women and even children to give your voice talent back to the Lord. Saint Augustine would say, "When you sing you pray twice". Indeed we are most blessed in this parish with our music ministry and we need new voices and musicians to come and join with us and become "glorfilers" in leading us in worship and praise at Mass and the other sacraments.

Finally thank you for all you are and all you do for our parish. I am deeply grateful for the gifts that God is doing here in our day.
