### **St. Serapian, Martyr – Nov. 14**

Serapian was born either in England or Ireland and served in the armies of Richard the Lion Hearted and Leopold VI. He then served in the army of Alfonso VIII. In 1222, after meeting with St. Peter Nolasco, he joined the Mercedarian Order. The goal of the Mercedarian order was to free captured Christians held by the Muslims. To this end, Serapian offered himself in exchange for some Christian captives. Serapian was killed either because the ransom money did not arrive or because he continued to preach Christianity. St. Serapian became the first martyr of the Mercedarian Order. He was hung by one arm and leg, then nailed to an X shaped cross and then dismembered. He is the patron saint of people suffering with arthritis. (JM)

All Parish Families preparing for the Baptism of their child must attend the Parish Baptismal Preparation Program. The program is held mostly on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday's of the month at 12 Noon in the Athletic Center (Damato Meeting Room). A copy of the child's birth certificate is needed. The sponsor must have proof of Confirmation, a sponsor certificate (see sponsor certificate information below) and must be at least 14 years of age.
