Four Blessed Irish Martyrs

During the reign of King Henry VIII and Queen Elizabeth I, it was a crime to speak out on Catholicism or to be reconciled to the Catholic Church, or celebrate the Mass, or to harbor Catholic priests. Practicing the faith brought death to many Catholics at that time. Bl. Matthew Lambert was a baker martyred with several companions in 1581 at Wexford. Bl. Robert Meyter was a Catholic sailor who professed his faith and died with Matthew Lambert. Bl. Edward Cheevers was another Catholic sailor who kept the faith. Bl. Patrick Cavanagh was a third Catholic sailor who remained faithful to the end and died with Matthew Lambert. These four Blesseds remained steadfast in the faith and refused to renounce the authority of the Pope. (JM)

Dear Parish Family,

Well we are half way through our summer of 2015. So far the weather has been pretty good to us; gorgeous days and for the most part dry. I hope you are taking advantage of being outdoors and letting God's beauty revive you.

I want to ask for patience as we await the number of tickets that will be allotted to our parish for Pope Francis visit to Madison Square Garden. When the time comes we will print in our bulletin a tear out sheet for people who interested in attending and then we will have a raffle and each name drawn will be awarded two tickets. Since there has been much work going on with the merging of parishes and the retirement of many personnel, I am sure there is a backlog of work on the Chancery due to that. It is with great sadness and yet much relief that we announced the passing of Father Victor Buebendorf on July 31st. He was presently the pastor of Saint Mary's Church in Rosebank for many years and had served for nearly his entire 51 years of priesthood on Staten Island. He's a native of Tottenville and there are Presentation Sisters still alive who taught him at Our Lady Help of Christians Church in Tottenville.

Father Vic was fondly remembered at Saint Charles Church, in Oakwood, and Holy Child Church in Eltingville and recently took on the merging of three parishes and mentoring Father Freddy Patino, of Immaculate Conception Church in Concord. Saint Joseph's, Saint Mary's. Rosebank and Immaculate Conception are now merged into one. Isn't it ironic that on the last day that daily Mass would have been held at Saint Mary's Parish he went home to God, July 31st the Feast of Saint Ignatius of Loyola.

Father Vic had tremendous love and knowledge of the Liturgy of the Church and a deep rooted love for Church music. When he was at Holy Child parish, he would take the monies collected from Mother's Day cards, and Father's Day cards and All Souls and take the music ministers to the NPM conventions around the country. NPM stands for the National Pastoral Musician workshop. Although he was rather a shy gentleman, he has had a profound impact on many current religious leaders on Staten Island.

Affectionately known at Holy Child Church as "Quick Vic", he could succinctly preach an amazing homily in a few minutes that captured people's imagination and attention and drove home powerful Gospel points. In his later years Father Vic suffered terribly with spinal stenosis. He was a tall man when I first met him, well over six foot, but he shrunk to about five foot two and with use of a walker it would move anyone to see just how determined and courageous he was to lead his parish family.

Father Vic was very welcoming and kind to me during the time of my ordination to the priesthood, along with Monsignor Robert Kelly and Father John Mancuso, I was given a great blessing in letting them help me prepare for my first Mass of Thanksgiving on November 5, 1977. Now that he is a priest forever may he have a wonderful time for all eternity enjoying the heavenly choirs of angels.

Both Bishop John O'Hara last Tuesday evening and Cardinal Dolan on last Wednesday morning offered the two funeral Masses at Saint Mary's Church. His good friends Monsignor Jim Dorney and Monsignor Peter Finn preached at the homily time. May he rest in
