**HERO/SAINT OF THE WEEK –**

**St. Raymond Nonnatus, Aug. 31**

Born in Portella, Spain, Raymond was called non-natus because he was delivered by cesarean section after his mother died. He entered the Merredarians, an order that worked for the release of Christians from the Moors. While in Algeria, he himself was captured and enslaved for several years. He suffered many tortures until rescued by St. Peter Nolasco. In 1239, St. Raymond was made a Cardinal at age 39. He died the following year. While living in the monastery, he was falsely accused of terrible sins. Heartbroken, he prayed to Jesus crucified, who appeared to him and said, "Did they not accuse me of falsehoods?" St. Raymond was soon proven innocent of all the false charges. He is the Patron Saint of those Falsely Accused and the Patron Saint of Midwives. (JM)

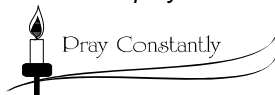
### PRAYER GROUP – HEALING MASS
