**BLESSED SEBASTIAN OF APARICIO, FEB. 25<sup>th</sup>**

*Born in 1502 into a poor family in Spain, he worked as a domestic servant and laborer. Later, Sebastian emigrated to Mexico and became very wealthy by building roads. He lived humbly, eating the poorest of foods and sleeping on a mat, all the while contributing generously to the poor. When he was over 60 years of age, he wed twice and each time, he was quickly widowed. At the age of 70, he entered religious life giving all his wealth to the poor. For the last 25 years of his life, he was a begging brother obtaining food for his Franciscan Order. He died in 1600 at the age of 98.*

ASH WEDNESDAY – FEB. 22<sup>ND</sup>

MASSSES: 7AM, 9AM, 12 Noon and 8PM

Ashes will be distributed at these Masses and at special services at 3:30PM and 4:30PM. Ashes will be distributed **ONLY** at Mass or at the Services, not before or after. They will only be distributed to those who have already received the Sacrament of Reconciliation (2<sup>ND</sup> Grade or above). Small children will be given a special blessing.

### LENT – BEGINS FEB. 22<sup>ND</sup>

- **Confessions** are heard every Saturday from 3:30 to 4PM and from 5 to 5:30PM in the church. The last confessions before Easter will be on Good Friday, April 6<sup>th</sup>, from 12 Noon to 2:30PM.
