HERO/SAINT OF THE WEEK – St. Anthony of Padua – June 13

St. Anthony, born in 1195 in Lisbon, Portugal, given the baptismal name Ferdinand. He entered the Augustinian Order but seeing the relics of five Franciscan martyrs, he entered the Franciscan Order and took the name Anthony. Unable to become a missionary, he dedicated his life to preaching, traveling through France, Spain and Italy, settling in Padua. Crowds flocked to hear him so he was forced to preach in open air. Miracles associated with him: his sermon to the fish in Rimini, the mule that knelt before the Blessed Sacrament and how he was seen holding the child Jesus. He is Patron Saint of Lost Things and the Poor. On his feast day, donations for St. Anthony's bread, are made for the poor. A popular novena is to visit a church that has a shrine to St. Anthony for nine Tuesdays asking him to obtain your request from God. (JM)

THE MOST HOLY BODY & BLOOD OF CHRIST

First Reading: Exodus 24:3-8

Moses explained to the people the commandments he had received from God. Upon hearing them, the entire community immediately agreed they would do as God had told them. Moses then sacrificed young bulls and sprinkled the people with their blood, calling it the blood of the covenant they had made.

Second Reading: Hebrews 9:11-15

Jesus did not offer God the blood of sacrifices, but instead he offered up his own blood to cleanse all people of the transgressions they had committed under the first covenant with God. Christ instead brought a new covenant, which, if kept, would lead to eternal life.

Gospel: Mark 14:12-16, 22-26

Jesus sent two of his disciples to prepare the Passover supper. During the meal he blessed bread and offered it to them saying, "This is my body." He then offered them wine and called it his blood, "the blood of the covenant, to be poured out on behalf of many."
