**Bl. Margaret Pole, Martyr – May 28**

Margaret Plantageret was born near Bath, England, the daughter of the Duke of Clarence and niece to King Edward IV and Richard III. She married Sr. Richard Pole and eventually was left a widow with 5 children. She was governess to Henry VIII's daughter Mary, and incurred her father's wrath when she disapproved of his marriage to Anne Boleyn. When her son Cardinal Pole wrote against the Acts of Supremacy, two of her sons were executed for being brothers of the Cardinal, and in 1539, Margaret was arrested for supposed complicity in a revolt. In 1541 when another uprising occurred, Margaret was beheaded without benefit of a trial, or proof of guilt, suffering martyrdom for the faith at age 70. –JM

## A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parish Family,

During this month and next month we have several members of our parish community who will be graduating, Pre K3, Pre K4, Kindergarten, Our Lady Star of the Sea School, all our primary schools, our Junior High Schools, Saint Joseph by the Sea High School, Monsignor Farrell High School, Moore Catholic High School, Notre Dame High School, Saint Peter's Boys High School, Saint John Villa Academy, Saint Joseph Hill Academy, Xaverian High School, Xavier High School, Tottenville High School, our local public high schools, and all the local colleges and universities.

God Bless You Graduates, you have worked hard and now earned the love, respect and applause of your family and friends. Our parish community of Our Lady Star of the Sea rejoices in your achievement and we wish you God's choicest blessings as you move forward in life.

On April 6-11, 14 very generous, brave and loving people joined me on a missionary trip to Kingston, Jamaica to spend 5 days at Christ Redeemer Monastery, home of the Missionaries of the Poor and we worked alongside the Brothers and volunteers of 5 different centers: The Lord's Place, Bethlehem, Jacob's Well, The Good Shepherd, and Faith Center. There we washed, applied lotion, shaved, bathed, fed, swept and helped feed several of the poorest abandoned people in Kingston. It was an enormous moment of faith for all of us, to pray with the Brothers for three hours and then do these corporal works of mercy. We took some photos and we also shared and recounted our reaction to this missionary effort. All of us moved way beyond our comfort zone and we saw poverty up close and yet there was a joy and love and a simplicity that I always call, "The Philanthropy of the Poor". On Tuesday evening May 24<sup>th</sup> at 7:30PM please join us in the Damato Room as we gather to testify and share the impact of this powerful experience. All are invited and, please God, we may have more people join with us next year.

I want to thank Martha Lemieux for sending me this little poem,  
**JUST FOR A MINUTE**

I remember when I was four, Mother would bring me 'round to the store and just outside the church she'd stand, and "Come In", she'd say, reaching down for my hand. "Just for a minute".

And then when I started going to school, She'd bring me down every day as a rule, but first the steps to the church we'd climb, and then she'd say: We'll go in – you've always got time. "Just for a minute".

The I got really big, I mean, seven years old, and I went by myself, but was always told. When you're passing by the church, don't forget to call, "And tell Our Lord about lessons and all, "Just for a minute".

Sometimes I run most of the way, or meet some guys and we stop to play. But I manage to squeeze out time enough to make it to the church where I pant and puff. "Just for a minute".

And now it's sort of a habit I've got, in the evening, coming from Casey's lot. Though it takes me out of my way a bit, to slip into church with my hat and mitt, "Just for a minute".

But sometimes I see the other fellow standing around and I just go yellow. I pass by the door, but a Voice from within seems to say, real say: "So you wouldn't come in "Just for a minute".

There are things inside of me, bad and good, that nobody knows and nobody could, except Our Lord, and I like Him to know, And He helps, when in a visit I go, "Just for a minute".

He finds it lonesome when nobody comes (There are hours upon hours when nobody comes) and He's pleased when anyone passing by stops in (though it's only a little guy) "Just for a minute".

I know what happens when people die, But I won't be scared, and I'll tell you why: When Our Lord is judging my soul, I feel, He'll remember the times I went into to kneel "just for a minute."
