#### St. Catherine of Alexandria Virgin and Martyr – Nov. 25

Catherine was born in Alexandria Egypt in the 4<sup>th</sup> Century. She was a noble lady endowed with beauty, wealth and learning. Having been converted to Christianity by a vision of Mary and the child Jesus, she preached and converted throughout Alexandria. For denouncing Emperor Maxentius fifty of her converts were burned to death. Catherine refused to deny the Faith, this landed her in prison where Catherine converted Maxentius's wife and 200 soldiers – all were put to death. St. Catherine was martyred on a spiked wheel, which, when it broke, she was beheaded. She is considered one of the Fourteen Holy Helpers, and was one of the voices heard by St. Joan of Arc. St. Catherine is Patroness of Jurists, Philosophers and Preachers. (JM)

We invite you to bring along your baby's Godparents to hear this special presentation. Please call the rectory for a Registration Packet before attending the Sunday Meeting. A copy of the child's birth certificate is needed. The sponsor must have proof of Confirmation, a sponsor certificate (see sponsor certificate information below) and must be at least 14 years of age. The Baptismal donation of \$100 and the yellow registration form must be brought to the Parish Office (Mon.-Fri. 9 to 4PM), prior to the Baptism Meeting. You may then bring the completed registration form to the meeting of your choice.
