#### Pastor's Report:

#### The State of the Parish: September 1, 2020 to August 31, 2021

#### 1. Introduction:

Often our happiness is the source of our smile, but sometimes our smile can be the source of our happiness, as well as the cause happiness of the people in our life. Because of the gifts God has given us we have been the reason for comfort, inner strength and happiness in the life of our family, even in these COVID circumstances. We celebrate our togetherness as a family. We thank God for our gift of faith in His plan for us and for our family. Our life is fragile and vulnerable, but our trust in His plan is stronger than ever.

We thank God for the inspiring inner strength being shown by our healthcare workers, teachers, parents and children; we invoke God's blessings upon them. We hope and pray that their heroism and self-sacrifice will lead us to better days ahead.

With the eyes of faith we, as individuals, couples, parents, children, family and friends, are able to derive strength from Him to build each other up in love and caring. This faith-filled inner strength is the core of our parish life.

#### 2. Sacramental and Pastoral Aspects:

We thank all our volunteers for everything they do to enhance our parish life. Additionally, our gratitude goes to our priests, deacon, and staff for ministering to our people so generously and lovingly. Each of us in some unique way makes our parish family a warm welcoming place for all to see the face of God.

#### 3. Our Lady Star of the Sea School:

Our parish school is a source of our pride. Under the leadership of Ms. Jeannine Roland, our principal, and Mrs. Patricia Gandelman, our Assistant Principal, with dedication of 27 teachers, 13 aides, and 3 staff members, we offered quality Catholic education in the 2020-2021 school year to 632 students. I applaud our school parents and our friends for the spectacular results in fundraising. Our school reported a total revenue of \$3,717,301, including tuition, fees and other income. The total expenditures added up to \$3,696,130.

#### 4. Religious Education:

A major component of our parish life is to assist our young people in rooting themselves in the good news of Jesus Christ. During the 2020-2021 school year 616 children from grades 1 thru participated in our Religious Education Program (CCD). Ms. Marie Ferro directs the program with the help of 50 volunteer catechists, aides, and staff members. We are so fortunate to have such dedication from them in giving faithformation to our youngsters.

#### 5. Financial Status:

Only with a heart filled with gratitude for your generosity can we look at our Parish Financial Report for the last fiscal year, (September 1, 2020 to August 31, 2021).

In addition to your generous offering in Sunday weekly donations, you also have been faithfully keeping up with fulfilling our Renew + Rebuild campaign. Your sacrifices and good will have helped our parish go forward meeting our needs and leading people to God, as the following numbers indicate:
